

The Friends of Shamrock

The historic steam saloon launch *Shamrock*, built 1906, is, at present, the only vessel of this type still operating on Windermere. She is in the top 200 on The Historic Ships Register, which is the marine equivalent of being a Grade 1 Listed Building.

She is operated by *The Shamrock Trust* and *The Friends of Shamrock* are a group of people whose purpose is to assist the Trust by allowing interested enthusiasts to raise money for this purpose and provide support.
